Contestant Entry Fee:

- Long Go #1 \$25/event
- Long Go #2 \$25/event
- Short Go \$ 0/event

Jackpot

- Each event will have a voluntary jackpot – Jackpot fee is \$15. All monies collected will be paid back based on entries.

Admission:

- Each contestant will get one guest pass for each performance.
- Tickets will be sold at the gate or can be ordered from PHSRA.
- Adults \$7.00/perf Children \$4.00/perf
- Adults \$15/weekend Children \$8/weekend

Entry Deadline:

- State Entry - February 18
 - Inform PHSRA if your State will compete at the Mid Atlantic Invitational Rodeo.
- State Contestant Entries – April 7
 - Visiting State Secretary will send PHSRA the individual entries from their state.
- Individual entries – April 21-22
 - This will be for PHSRA and Individuals coming from a state other than WV and VA.
 - Call-in will be April 21 , 5:00PM -11:00PM

- Call-backs – May 1, 6:00PM- 10:00PM
 - Call to check if you are in Slack or Performance
 - Day sheets will be sent to State Secretaries and will be listed on the website by May 5th.

Stalls:

- All horses must be kept in a stall - \$45/stall/weekend.
- Reserve Stalls when calling in entries.
- Straw only - No Sawdust or Shavings.
- Straw will be available for purchase.
