

Pennsylvania High School Rodeo Association Rules of Conduct and Contestant Responsibilities

***** To all contestant and parents: By signing this document you are confirming that you have read everything below and agree to all numbered items listed. If you have questions regarding information below please contact you PHSRA President or a Board Member.*

1. Be in rodeo attire 1 hour before, and during the rodeo. Dress code includes hat, long sleeve shirt (buttoned and tucked in) western boots and jeans. All Meetings of PHSRA require proper dress code, *no exceptions*. There will be a student meeting at every rodeo and they are mandatory.
2. Each member is to be responsible for call-ins to designated board member or secretary. All information needed (stalls, hook-ups for trailers, campsites, etc.) will be the responsibility of member and parent/s or guardians.
3. Each member will be responsible for all fees affiliated with each PHSRA event. This responsibility includes monies for fundraising set forth by the board. If a member cannot attend a rodeo it is their responsibility to contact the rodeo secretary. If member "turns out" it is understood that fees will still be charged. If turn out is due to injury or sickness of horse or member, a signed excuse from a doctor or veterinarian will be required within 24 hours.
4. Member and Parent/s or Guardian agrees that any type of misconduct will not be tolerated. No alcohol or tobacco is to be on the rodeo grounds. Profanity of any kind will not be tolerated.
5. Members will always display team support and good sportsmanship. If called upon to act as a student director or assist in rodeo set up/tear down it will be done without hesitation.
6. It is understood that payback will be available after rodeo is complete or when designated by PHSRA board.
7. As a member of High School Rodeo it is understood that discipline of a horse in the arena will not be tolerated. Training of horses should be done at home and not in front of spectators.
8. Due to a decision of the 2011-2012 board there will be no sale of raffle tickets this year, however, each family will now be responsible for fund raising the amount of \$400. All senior and junior membership dues, sponsorships, and fund raising monies are due **no later** than November 1st 2011. Should these funds remain unpaid after this date contestants will not be permitted to rodeo until these financial commitments are met.

By signing this document, all agree to abide by all rules in the National High School Rodeo Association Rule Book. Also by signing, it is acknowledged that any violation will result first in a warning and a second offense will result in the removal of points and possible further sanctions from the board of Directors.
